



This problem was mainly due to a lack of information about the possibilities at the end of their studies, but also to an underdeveloped professional network. 




Synapse Medicine

Synapse Medicine is a French start-up founded in 2017 by healthcare professionals sharing a common vision: drug informations should be easily accessible to everyone. In fact, 10.000 to 30.000 patients die each year in France (1) because of the misuse of drugs. In the United States, this problem affects 1 in 250 people each year.

Synapse Medicine has developed a Medication Intelligence platform dedicated to the proper use of medication. The start-up helps doctors to prescribe, pharmacists to dispense and patients to better take their medications, via its SaaS platform.


