

Discover the associations that form the Réseau Biotechno.

Our associations come from all over France. Among them, YR2I, StraPa, JeCCo and ADIC contribute to organise the Forum Biotechno Paris; ADDAL and SPB help to organize Forum Biotechno EST; Glob'Alps participates in the organization of Forum Biotechno AuRA. Bio'M association was created to organize Forum Biotechno SUD. In addition, this year we are welcoming 2 new associations: SPB and Interpharm. We also have people participating in the Réseau Biotechno missions in Bordeaux and Toulouse... Who knows, maybe soon there will be a Forum Biotechno Sud-Ouest...?









<u>Addal</u> (Association des doctorants et docteurs alsaciens) is an association gathering Ph.D. candidates and doctors from different disciplines. The main objectives of Addal are promoting doctoral training, informing Ph.D. candidates about career prospects following the Ph.D., and encouraging Ph.D. candidates and doctors to get acquainted; in addition to defending their rights.



<u>Bio'M</u> (Biotechno Marseille) aims to help students and young scientists discover the different career paths that exist in biotechnology. We are a team of research associates, PhD students and postdocs who work together to organise a yearly forum since 2022: Forum BiotechnoSUD. We also work in collaboration with the Réseau Biotechno by helping in some of their missions and with the planification of monthly webinars and newsletters.



Created in 2013, YR21 (for Young researchers of Imagine Institute) association is supported by the Imagine Institute. Our missions are :

- Gather and represent Master students, PhD students, post-doctoral researchers and engineers
- Reinforce young researchers participation to the Scientific life of the Institute
- Organize scientific and social events to promote communications between Imagine Institute members
- Inform students and young researchers about doctoral training and their opportunities, as well as on possible career redirections.



<u>Doc' En Herbe</u> organize an event, the PhD Days. This is a meeting between doctoral students involved in biology, ecology, plant sciences, genetics, evolution and agronomy to present and share their work in an oral presentation or a poster. In addition, exceptional guests from the research world are invited to present their career and main research and to make connections with young researchers.







The goals of <u>ADELIS</u> (Association des Doctorants et des jEunes chercheurs de L'Institut de Recherche de l'hôpital St Louis) are first of all, to highlight and support the research of the students. We want to support students as they work on their thesis. Moreover, we want to promote professional insertion, building connections with the extensive network of student and professional contacts. The last objective is to share experiences and meet new people by participating in the events organized by the ADELIS as well by other associations.



<u>StaPa</u> is the Official Young Researcher Association of Institut Pasteur! We organize social, scientific and cultural events on campus and outside. Our role is to enable the young researcher to connect with Institut Pasteur and we help them foster their ideas and manage their careers. Furthermore, we offer a networking base to organize many activities for personal growth both in academia and private research. Lastly, we work in the frame of Institut Pasteur International Network, bringing the StaPa spirit to every Institut Pasteur around the globe!



<u>Glob'Alps</u> is an association founded in 1999, originally named Globule38. It is run by and for doctoral students from the Chemistry and Life Sciences doctoral school at Grenoble Alpes University. Its main aim is to bring together young researchers from Grenoble's three campuses through a variety of events. It also aims to integrate those from other regions and countries. Support is also provided for masters students in their career choices, whether in the academic or private sector.



<u>Jecco</u> (Jeunes Chercheurs de l'Institut Cochin) is a non-profit association, aiming to gather Cochin researchers, creating bonds and promoting exchanges between teams, as well as with other institutes in Paris! Each event is open to all members of the Institut, not only PhD students. We organize fun afterlab events, professional afterworks and a symposium every year!









<u>BioDocs-Lyon</u> is an association of young researchers in Biology from Lyon aiming to help the professional integration of young graduates in Life Sciences. The activities of BioDocs-Lyon (Round Tables, "Employment" Workshops, Company visits, "Network" Cocktails) take place as small group meetings between our members and professionals from the bio-industry sector. In this way, members can discover the diversity of positions that are accessible with a Bac+5/Bac+8 diploma in the Life Sciences.



The Students and Post-docs Board (SPB) is an independent, non-political, nonprofit association formed by doctoral students and post-doctoral fellows from the Institute of Genetics, Molecular and Cellular Biology (IGBMC), a leading European biomedical research center located near Strasbourg. Our activities include scientific poster sessions, career lunches, language workshops, and social events like board game nights and retreats. SPB collaborates with top European research institutes to host the Graduate Students Symposium and has been involved in organizing editions of Forum Réseau Biotechno and Forum BioChem. These events foster scientific exchange, networking, and provide insights into various career opportunities for young researchers.



InterPharm is a student association based at the School of Pharmacy of the Université Paris-Saclay. The aim of InterPharm is to organize multiple scientific, social, and cultural events in order to facilitate and guide the integration of students at the Université Paris-Saclay. Its membership includes all the students (20+ nationalities) of the International master in pharmacy «Development of Drugs and Health Products». The major event of InterPharm, each year, is the organization of the International Symposium on Research Advances in Global Health "SYMGLOH".



Since its creation in 1997, the <u>ADIC</u> has officially been representing PhDs, PostDocs and every other young researcher of Institut Curie. Our mission is to help young researchers from the institute to integrate into our scientific community, to promote networking possibilities, to help their transition towards the next career step and to provide visibility for our Institute.
